Dear Parents/Carers,

Although this has been a relatively short school week, the children have already produced a wealth of amazing learning. It was fabulous to observe the children in Class 6 all enjoying their 'Cozy Club' reading time in class this afternoon, snuggled up quietly reading books (some of them under the tables). What a fabulous way to enjoy a book! Fabulous Class 6!

School Rules

We have such a caring and considerate school, where the trust and relationships that we build make us part of a huge Frampton family. We expect high standards of behaviour, for the benefit of all children and adults in school. This week I held assemblies with all Key Stages to promote our three school rules. The children should be able to recite them to you, but I would like you to know them too. These are to '**be ready, be respectful and be safe**'. We discussed what this looks like, in the classroom, in the corridors and outside. I wonder if any of your children have recently held a door open for you? I mentioned this as one way to show respect and suddenly I have had every door opened for me! We aim to promote positive attitudes and outstanding behaviour and we ask for parental support in all matters of discipline. We all play a vital role in shaping the attitude and behaviour of children. All the staff want the very best for the children academically and emotionally.

Ready We would like to ensure that our school day starts calmly with children walking in through the school gates.

Respectful We have discussed how we can show respect for our environment and property at school, indoors and outside.

Safe (Road Safety Concerns)

There have been reports of a number of incidents last term when children have run directly onto neighbouring roads outside of school at the end of the day. This is deeply concerning. This has happened lower down on Rectory Road and children have also run out onto the road, directly in front of the school following a club (eg at 4.15pm) when the road closure is not in place. Consequently I have decided to close one of the gates each morning and evening to provide a physical barrier to children arriving at and leaving school. We have already put this in place, and I thank you for your support in promoting a road safety message to school.

I have arranged Road Safety Workshops, provided by the Road Safety Team at South Gloucestershire for all children at Frampton during the first week of Term 4. Details will be shared later in the term.

Inset Day.

The Inset Day in Term 4 has been included in the dates at the bottom of this list. It is Friday 8th April and it is a joint Inset with the other schools in our local alliance.
