Dear Parents/Carers,

Our Christian value for this term is 'Honesty.' Through our collective worship and classroom discussions, we will be exploring what it means to be truthful, trustworthy and courageous in admitting mistakes. We aim to help children understand that honesty strengthens relationships, builds character and fosters a positive community. We encourage you to support this learning at home by discussing the importance of honesty in everyday situations. You might reflect with your child on moments when being truthful was challenging but rewarding or share examples from your own experiences.

Home to School Agreement

We have made a small change to the Home to School Agreement Policy. Item 3 of the Parent/ Carer list has been changed from 'Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour' to 'Support **and model** the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour.' If you have already given consent for this and are happy with this change you do not need to do anything. If you would, however, like to modify your consent please let the office know.



Nut Free School

A reminder that we have some children with severe nut allergies so no nuts can be brought into school. This also includes Coconut. Thank you for support with this matter.

We would also like to remind you that if grapes are brought into school, they must be cut in half.



Uniform

Children should wear their school uniform to school each day, apart from on their PE days when they should wear their school PE kit. Wearing a school uniform is important as it helps to create a sense of belonging and promotes pride and self-confidence. On PE days, children should not wear football or rugby kits. PE t-shirts do not need to have the school logo; a plain t-shirt in the child's house colour is perfect.

The school uniform is as follows:

- Navy sweatshirts or cardigans

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- Pale blue shirts, blouses or polo shirts
- Grey or black school style full length trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafores
- Navy fleece
- Plain black school shoes (No trainers please)

In summer children can wear checked or striped blue and white dresses or plain grey/black school style short trousers or culottes (not ¾ length fashion trousers or leggings).

We currently have a large pile of lost property at the front of school. If you are missing an item, please check this box. We also ask that you label your child's uniform. Thank you for your support with this.
