Our Christian Value this term is 'Service'

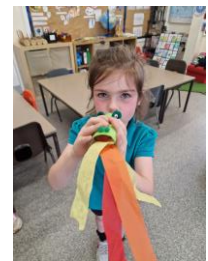
Dear Parents/Carers,

Attendance Reminder

Good attendance is essential for children to make the most of their learning opportunities and build positive routines for the future. We kindly remind parents and carers that holidays should not be taken during term time. The Department for Education's statutory guidance, 'Working Together to Improve School Attendance,' makes it clear that a leave of absence during term time should only be granted in exceptional circumstances. It is unlikely that a leave of absence will be granted for the purpose of a family holiday. All requests for a leave of absence must be made using the form available on the website or from the school office. Please note that permission is granted at the Headteacher's discretion.

In August 2024, a new national threshold for when Penalty Notices must be considered came into effect. A Penalty Notice will likely be issued if a child has 10 or more unauthorised sessions (equivalent to 5 school days) within a rolling 10-week period, for any reason. The fine is currently £80 per parent, per child (if paid within 21 days), rising to
