### ***Our Christian Value this term is 'Justice'***

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 had a fantastic week away on their residential trip to Manor at the start of the term, where they took part in a range of outdoor activities, including climbing, caving and canoeing. It has been wonderful to hear the children speaking so enthusiastically about their experiences, and I know they will have made memories that will stay with them forever. Thank you to the staff who gave up their time to accompany the children and make the trip such a success.

Our Year 1 pupils have completed their Phonics Screening Check this term, and our Year 4 pupils have also completed their Multiplication Tables Check. The children approached these assessments with confidence and determination, and we are incredibly proud of the effort they put in. Well done to all our pupils for showing resilience, perseverance and a positive attitude towards their learning.

The Year 3s had the privilege of being welcomed into the Bristol Progressive Synagogue last week as part of their Religions and Worldview topic about Judaism. They were shown around the Synagogue, given a chance to try on traditional Jewish clothing, explore the Hebrew texts and even take out the very special Torah scrolls, which we learnt would have taken over a year to write by hand. They tried some of the special homemade Challah bread and were shown how Sabbath might be celebrated. We were proud of the respectful way the pupils acted and the insightful questions they asked.



Yesterday, a group of our children visited another school to take part in a music event alongside pupils from other local schools within our hub. They represented our school brilliantly, demonstrating enthusiasm and confidence throughout the day. It was fantastic to see them performing together, developing their musical skills and enjoying the experience of making music with others. As part of the day, the children also spent time in the woods, exploring musical notation through nature. They used natural materials to create musical symbols and patterns, combining creativity, teamwork and musical learning in a unique outdoor environment.
